



Year End Awards & Criteria

Principal's Honour Roll - Criteria for Principal's Honour Roll is to have achieved all A's based on letter grades in all their subject areas **excluding PE**. Students must not have any 'S' or 'N' in the Effort category on their report card.

Award: Each Term: Certificate & Movie Pass
Year End (for all 3 Terms): Certificate & Medallion

Academic Honour Roll - Award is based on each term; students who have achieved **A & B's only (at least one A)** in the 5 academic subjects (English, Math, Social Studies, Science and French) will achieve Academic Honour roll status.

Award: Each Term: Certificate (given out in class)
Year End (for all 3 Terms): Certificate & Pin (all three terms)

Effort Honour Roll - Students who have all 'Gs' for the work habit category in every subject will achieve Effort Honour Roll status.

Award: Each Term: Certificate (given out in class)
Year End: Certificate & Pin (all three terms)

Academic Award - Awarded to TWO students in each grade. They will be recognized for the top academic standing in the class for the school year. This award is presented to the students in each class who best display the following qualities:

1. Maintains a high level of academic excellence in the areas of English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, and French throughout the year.
2. Displays outstanding work habits and application to schoolwork.

Award: Plaque (school), a keeper plaque & Chapters gift card

Rhonda Pauls Fitness Award – PAC award given to a student involved in a variety of sports throughout the year, both in school and extra-curricular.

Award: Name on Cup (stays at school)
Other award as per PAC choice.



Athletic Award - Awarded to TWO students (one boy and one girl) per grade participating in ATMS school sports. These students must demonstrate:

1. Outstanding athletic ability
2. Superior sportsmanship
3. Leadership skills
4. Must have participated on at least two extracurricular teams at ATMS.

Award: Name on Trophy (stays at school), other Award as per Athletic Director choice

Fine Arts Award - Awarded to TWO students from each grade. For the Fine Arts Award, these students must demonstrate:

1. Outstanding artistic ability in the area of drama, music, or art
2. Dedication to excellence evident in the quality produced.

Award: Plaque (stays at school), keeper plaque & pin

Band Award – Awarded to TWO students from each grade. For the Band Award, these students must demonstrate:

1. Excellence in performance on their instrument
2. Excellence in their development of other musical skills
3. A positive attitude
4. Cooperation
5. Leadership amongst their peers

Information Technology Award - Awarded to TWO students from each grade. For the Information Technology Award recipients must have outstanding achievement in an information Technology course, exceptional work habits and demonstrate a willingness to help others.

Award: Plaque (stays at school), keeper plaque & \$10 iTunes card

Citizenship Award - Awarded with input by their peers, up to TWO students from each class. The recipients will have demonstrated throughout the year:

1. Respect for school rules and expectations
2. The ability and willingness to work with others
3. Polite manners
4. Kindness
5. Honesty in all aspects of school life
